

# Deworming Protocol

## Horse (over 1 year)



Administer paste every 2 months

An example of a deworming schedule:

<b>January:</b>	Pyrantel pamoate (ex. Strongid paste)
<b>March:</b>	Ivermectin or moxidectin* (ex. Equell, Zimectrin, Eqvalan, Quest*)
<b>May:</b>	Fenbendazole (ex. Panacur, Safe-guard)
<b>July:</b>	Ivermectin or moxidectin* (ex. Equell, Zimectrin, Eqvalan, Quest*)
<b>September:</b>	Pyrantel pamoate (ex. Strongid paste)
<b>November:</b>	Ivermectin plus praziquantel or moxidectin plus praziquantel (ex. Equimax, ComboCare*, Zimectrin Gold)

Moxidectin (Quest, ComboCare) should not be used in foals less than six months of age, ponies, miniature horses, old, thin horses, or pregnant mares.

Alternatively, a daily dewormer such as Strongid C could be administered. If your horse is on the daily dewormer then be sure to administer ivermectin (ex. Equell, Zimectrin, Eqvalan) in the spring and ivermectin plus praziquantel (ex. Equimax, Zimectrin Gold) in the fall.
